



Corinne Gibbons Melt Show

Australian indie jazz/fusion artiste Corinne Gibbons loves Singapore so much that she released her latest and third album, *Melt*, in the Lion City ahead of the planned launch in her home country. Gibbons, who started her singing career at the age of 19, has called Singapore home for the past three years. Her chocolate-like voice is constantly compared to that of music legends like Karen Carpenter, Kate Bush and Eva Cassidy.

Melt is an intimate journey into Gibbons' world and reveals the life changes she had experienced in the last few years, insights gained from her days in Singapore and reflections from her extensive travels around the world.

To showcase what *Melt* is all about, Gibbons will perform three *Melt* shows here. The shows are an extraordinary fusion of image and sound, and feature 10 tracks from her new album. The songs contain a touch of pop, rock, jazz, country and even a little bit of Celtic influence.

Complementing Gibbons' beautiful music are extraordinary footage of exotic animals like polar bears, penguins and seals; and dramatic landscapes of ice, desert, and metropolis. The footage was shot over a period of five years by Gibbons' friend Toni Houston during the latter's expeditions with *National Geographic* Lindblad Expedition.
